Prerequisites for Business (LPAB) licensing:

- 1.) Pesticide Business (LPAB) examination Should be taken by whomever with the business would be the WVDA's contact for enforcement issues. Is not required to be someone who will be applying pesticides/herbicides for the business.
- 2.) Must have at least one employee who can be named as a Commercial Applicator Someone who has taken and passed the WVDA's pesticide examinations or is eligible for reciprocity from the states of PA, MD, OH, VA.
- 3.) Must have a WV State Tax ID number for the business location becoming licensed to apply pesticides/herbicides. Must contact the WV State Tax Department to acquire (304) 558-3333. A copy of the Business Registration Certificate sent to the business by the WV State Tax Department, once a WV State Tax ID number is issued, is required to be sent to the WVDA.
- 4.) Must have proof of current insurance. \$300,00 for bodily injury, \$100,000 for property damage. Workers Comp for employees.
- 5.) \$60 licensing fee (check or money order made payable to the West Virginia Department of Agriculture).
